

## 2026 Basic Leader Course Packing List – Camp Williams, Utah

**\*\*Bring enough articles for the entire length of the course. Laundry facilities are available\*\***

### Duty Day Uniform

- OCP Duty Uniform
- Patrol Cap w/nametag
- OCP Uniform undershirts
- Combat Boots
- Boot socks
- IPFU Jacket
- IPFU Shirts (Long and Short Sleeve)
- IPFU Trunks w/ liner
- Undergarments (Compression wear is not authorized during recording of height/weight)
- Brassieres (if applicable)
- Socks, Athletic calf or crew length (white or black)
- Running Shoes
- Black Cap, synthetic or micro fleece

### Hygiene / Barracks Items

- Towel / Washcloth
- Personal Hygiene Kit (IE soap, shampoo, lotion, shaving items, sunscreen, etc...)
- Applicable medications (if required)
- Pillow & Bed linen (Twin Long-sized - neutral or solid colors)
- Key or Combination Lock (For storage locker)
- Laundry Bag

### Field Gear

- Medium Ruck Sack, Tactical Backpack, or Assault Pack
- ACH (Kevlar)  
"Pro-Tec helmets and those similar to them are not approved for use or as a substitute for Kevlar head protection when operating or riding as a passenger in a tactical vehicle," as per Range Regulation UTNGR 385-63-1.
- FLC or IOTV (no armor plates)
- Gloves
- Camelbak/Hydration System, 2 quarts minimum
- Modular Sleeping System / Civilian Sleeping Bag
- Wet/Cold Weather Gear (Cold weather Oct-April)
- Head lamp or flashlight (Red/White Light Capable, Recommended for Land Navigation)
- Watch (Recommended for Land Navigation)

### Dress Uniform **\*\*Memorandum required for attending without dress uniform\*\***

- ASU/AGSU Set (jacket/trousers, undershirt LS, necktie (male), neck tab (female), etc...)
- Beret (for ASU), Service Cap or Garrison Cap (for AGSU)
- Dress Shoes

### Miscellaneous Items **\*\*Seasonal/Cold Weather, Civilian Attire, Classroom items, etc.\*\***

- Appropriate Civilian Attire (as needed)
- Composition notebook / Pencils / Pens / Pocket notebook
