- The document you submitted with your Education Goal does not meet the requirements to be considered an Evaluated Degree Plan.

# Evaluated Degree Plan (EDP) What it is?

- An official academic document provided by your school that specifies all degree requirements for graduation.
- An EDP shows:
  - School name
  - Soldier's name
  - Name of degree
  - Degree level
  - Total number of credits the degree requires
  - Classes required (full list)
  - Evaluation of all successfully completed prior coursework
  - Evaluation of your Joint Services Transcript
  - Evaluation of test-based credits (AP courses, CLEP, DSST)

## **May also include:**

- Summary of credits
  - 120 SH required, 25 SH transferred, 15 SH completed, 80 SH needed
- Academic Advisor or Evaluator Name
- School Seal, Signature, or other marking indicating it is an official audit degree

# Evaluated Degree Plan (EDP) Be Sure YOURS Is Correct!

- To ensure your Evaluated Degree Plan is correct and contains all the coursework/training/education you have completed in the past
  - Send the following documents to your current school's Registrar Office:
    - Official Joint Services Transcripts (Current)
    - **ALL** official college level examination transcripts (CLEP, DSST, Uexcel, AP, etc.)
    - **ALL** official transcripts from every college you have attended
  - **Even if you have provided these documents to previous colleges/schools—make sure your current school receives the official documents!!!!**

Effective 1 August 2023, Soldiers using TA will be required to provide an Evaluated Degree Plan (EDP) prior to completing two courses.

- If you have already completed two courses, your account will have a blocker/hold until you provide your EDP
- This will prevent you from requesting TA for future courses



YOU SHALL NOT BE FUNDED

**To avoid any delays in requesting and processing TA requests, provide your EDP to your Education Center before 1 August 2023**

# Evaluated Degree Plan Summary

- An Evaluated Degree Plan (EDP) is an official document from your school that lists information about your degree
- An EDP shows the total number of credits/hours:
  - Required for the degree
  - Already completed with the school
  - Transferred in and applied to the degree
  - Remaining for the degree
- Effective 1 Aug 2023, after you request funding for 2 classes or 6 credits (whichever comes first) without an EDP posted to your account, ArmyIgnitED will place a funding blocker/hold

- You can Submit your EDP by attaching a PDF copy to the message
