

Utah Guard's Proposed Building Boom

The Utah National Guard is rolling out one of its largest modernization efforts in decades, shifting units and upgrading facilities across the state. The changes will bring thousands of soldiers into new communities, while also investing millions of dollars into construction and infrastructure.

- ! **Cedar City** is set to receive aviation units from West Jordan in Spring 2026.
- ! **Logan** plans to station a new infantry unit, adding 70+ soldiers.
- ! **North Ogden (DDO)** is planning for an added military intelligence capacity.
- ! **South Weber (Ogden Armory)** is slated for over 200 new soldiers with infantry headquarters.
- ! **Nephi** is planning to house 140 engineers once construction delays are resolved.
- ! **St. George** has a long-range plan to add an infantry company of 140+ soldiers by 2028.
- ! **Vernal** is planning to welcome a transportation company in 2026, with 30+ additional troops.
- ! **Tooele** is penciled in for an infantry unit by 2028.
- ! **Camp Williams** has plans for a new entry gate on the south side.
- ! **Price/Helper** is expected to get a new Field Maintenance Shop (FMS) at a recently acquired Camping World site.

Zoom out: From southern Utah to the Wasatch Front, these moves represent a sweeping realignment designed to modernize the Guard's footprint and bring its facilities in line with the state's growing defense needs.
